Management & Positioning


- Best positioned and used for hay, grazing, or silage
- Sweet stalked, mid-maturing hybrid, high yield performance
- 8' to 10' in height and has very good standability
- Tolerates drought stress very well
- Should be cut in the soft dough stage for highest tonnage and best quality
- Good choice for double crop with excellent early growth
- Quality medium maturity cane hay or silage

Seeding Rates (lbs./acre)

Low rainfall on rows	5-8 lbs
Low rainfall on drilled	7-10 lbs
High rainfall / irrigated on rows	12-18 lbs
High rainfall / irrigated on drilled	18-25 lbs
