**Hard Red Spring**
**Management & Positioning**

- Hard red spring wheat that compliments our popular Ambush variety
- CSO variety, farmers are required to sign a no saved seed agreement
- Widely adapted to many areas of MT, ND, MN, and SD
- A well balanced variety, with slightly more yield and slightly less protein than Ambush
- Improved resistance to Fusarium head scab compared to Ambush

**Management Tips**

- Scout and apply fungicides as needed
- Avoid fields with a known history of severe bacterial leaf streak

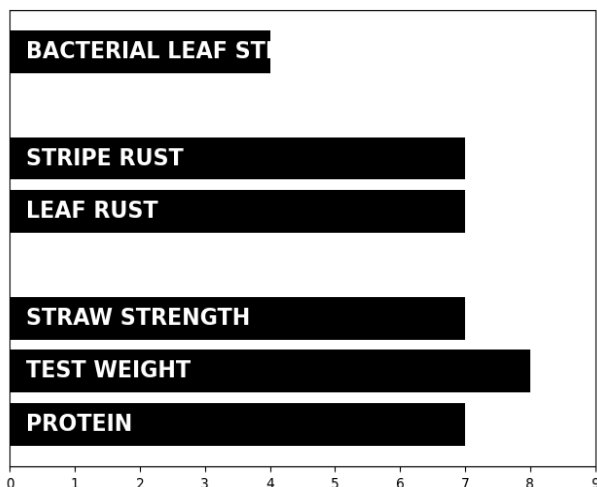
