1.5 to 2.0

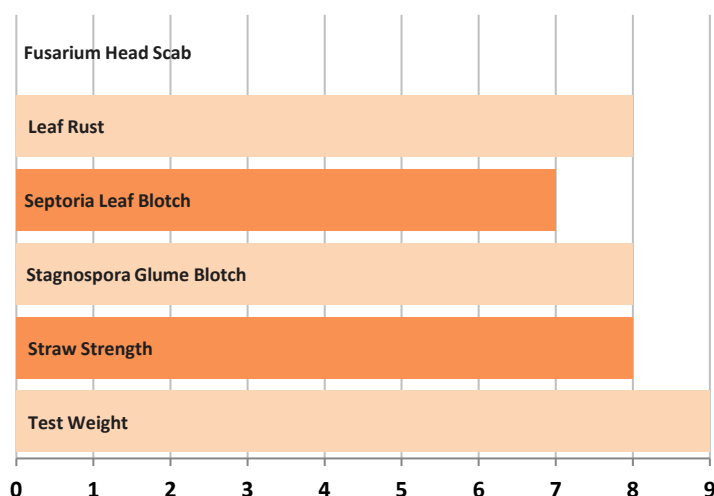
