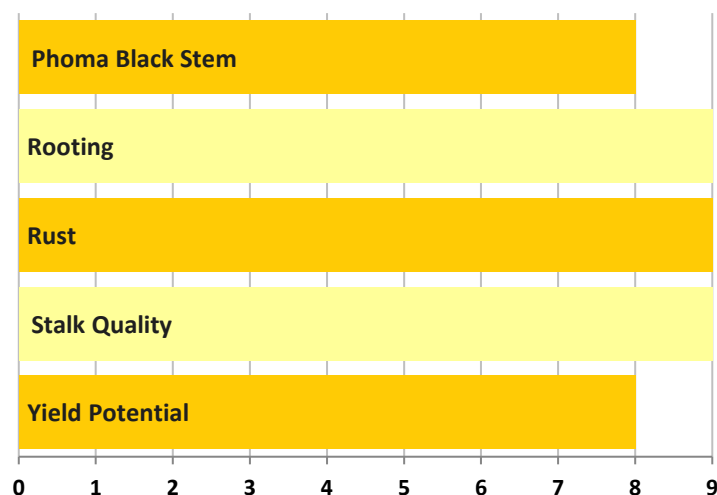
Management & Positioning

- Improved version of H49HO19 CL
- Oleic acid levels can vary due to environment and proximity to non-high oleic hybrids
- Medium-late maturing hybrid suited for North Dakota south of I-94 and south SD, CO, KS and TX
- Average plant height
- Excellent seed set and retention
- Great standability with very good stalk strength
- Oil content can vary with environmental conditions
