Management Comments

- **Sorgo-forage:** shorter plant height, slightly taller than 705F, normally 7-9 foot
- **Large grain head and very leafy produce sweet nutritional silage**
- **Good palatability and excellent feed values**
- **High tonnage and very high sugar content silage**
- **Moderate tolerance to downy mildew**
- **In previous years, Super Sile 30 has qualified as dual purpose, insurance approved**

Management Guidelines

Seeding Rates (lbs. /acre)

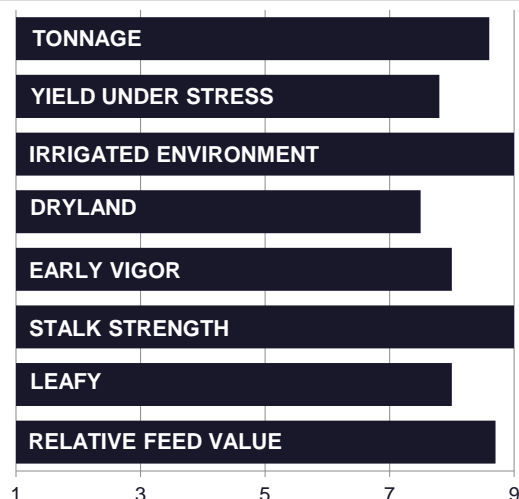
- Low rainfall and on rows..... **5-8 lbs**
- Low rainfall and drilled..... **10-18 lbs**
- High rainfall/irrigated on rows..... **8-10 lbs**
- High rainfall/irrigated on drilled... **15-25 lbs**

- **Harvest at whole plant moistures between 65-70% for highest feed values**
- **Harvest should begin when grain is in soft dough stage and grain black layers**

- Silage..... **9**
- Tonnage..... **8.5**
- Greenchop..... **9**
- Photoperiod Sensitive (headless)... **No**
- Protein Content..... **Excellent**
- Plant Height..... **Short**
- Early Vigor..... **Excellent**
- Standability..... **Excellent**
- Harvestability..... **Harvest at Dough Stage**
- Drought Tolerance..... **Good**
- Heat Tolerance..... **Very Good**
